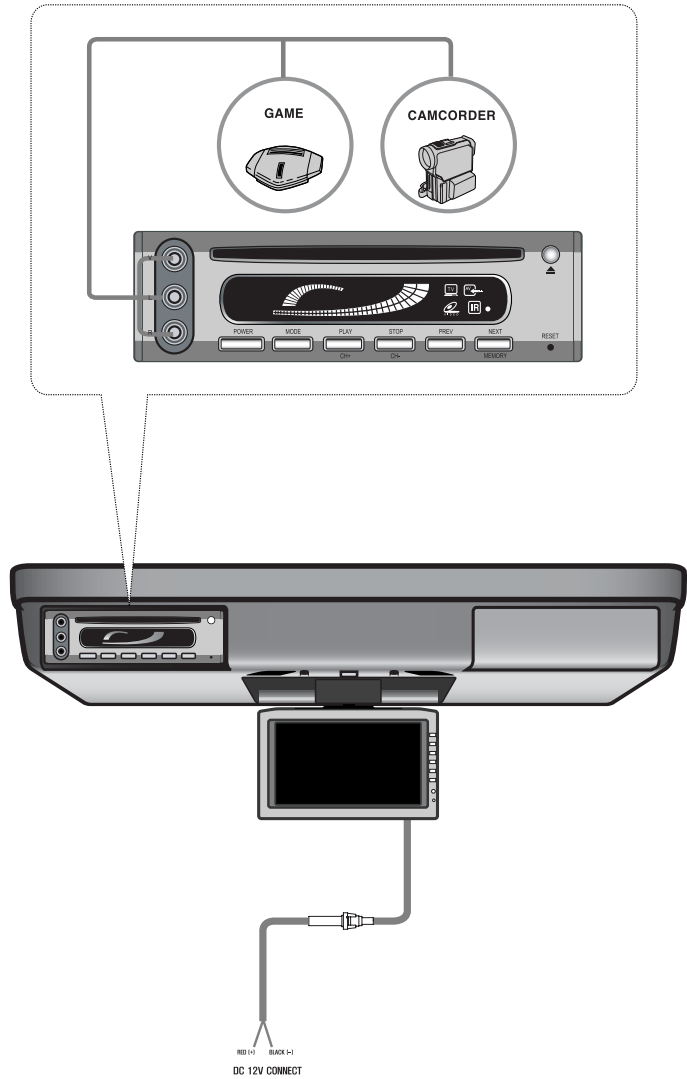
Preparations before operation

1. Do not open covers and repair yourself, refer servicing to qualified personnel.

- Please turn off the power of the DVD Player firstly before cut the car power off, if you want to see the next scene of the DVD title
(Of courses, you can see the next scene of the DVD title in case of turn on/off the DVD Player Properly)
- Do not cut the car power supply off while a disc is played, because it can cause damage in the DVD Player.
(Be sure to turn off the DVD Player, and then cut the car power supply off.)

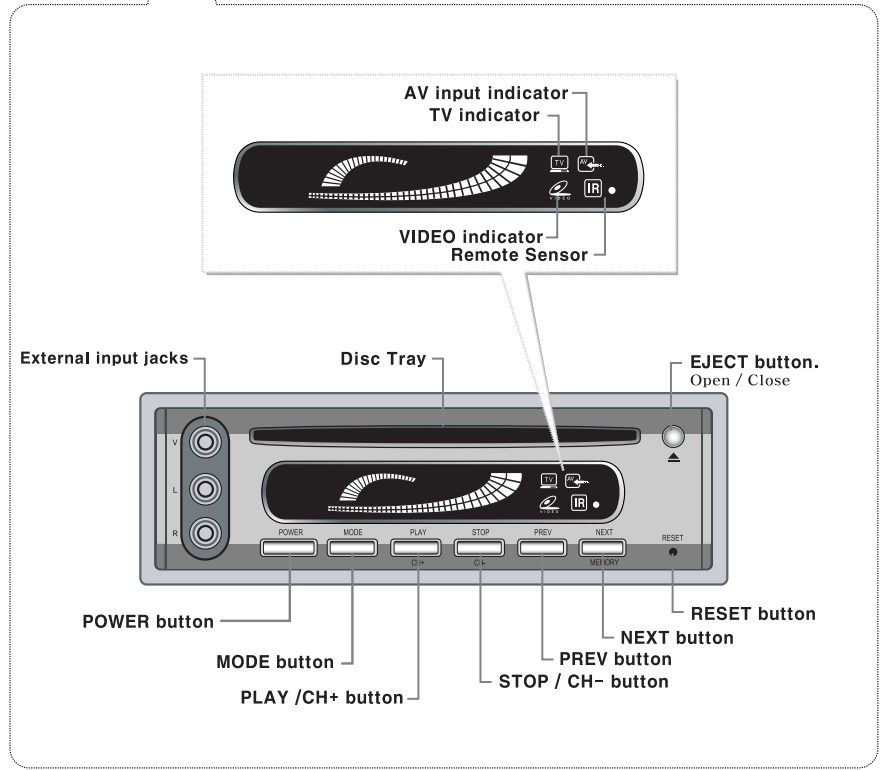

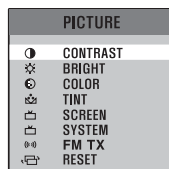

Region code

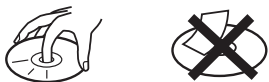
Your DVD player is designed and manufactured to region management information that is recorded on a DVD disc. The region number of this DVD Player is 3 and Plays free code also.

How to deal with disk

Don't touch the face carving information.
Don't stick label or glue-based note on disk (Don't use disks with remaining glue or damaged gluey label, it might result in damages to your DVD Player.
Don't put discs at straight under the sunshine. And park your car under the shade.

Wipe softly with a wet cloth and then with a dry one.
Before playback, wipe the disc outwards from the center with clean cloth.
Do not use any type of solvent such as thinner, benzene, commercially available cleaners or antistatic spray.
Don't use scratched disc to avoid damaging your DVD Player.

The Color system set by this unit does not match With that of TV/Monitor. Please check your System of the unit.

Distorted sound



Adjust the video system by pressing TV system button.(PAL, NTSC, MULTI)

The remote controller doesn't work properly



Remove the obstacles between the remote control unit and remote control sensor. Operate the remote controller in a short distance.

Displayed "DISK ERROR" on the screen



Set the power button to OFF and then back to ON alternatively, Turn off the power, disconnect the power plug and then reconnect it.

Caution

When a disk is brought from a cold environment to a hot one, there could be steam on the face of disk or water will appear the pickup lens. It will effect the play
