

Installation of all TV monitors must be out of the driver's field of sight.




Use extra caution with any liquids in your car. If you or your child spill any liquid on these products, pull your vehicle to the roadside and turn the key off to disconnect

This product is designed for operation with a 12 Volt DC, negative ground vehicle. It is not suitable for operation under other conditions or voltages.




Check Point

- 1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to -4°F $\sim +176$ °F. Your vehicle can reach temperatures up to 212°F in the summertime.
- 2. From time to time when your vehicle is extremely hot or cold you must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle for operating temperatures to return to normal operating ranges. Your monitor will return to its normal functions when these operating ranges are reached.
- 3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (+/-30 degrees).







Remote Controller




Power And Mode Selection

Power ON/OFF

Press the **POWER** button on the remote control or on the unit(\bigcirc) to turn the power on. Press the **POWER**(\bigcirc) button to turn the power off.

Monitor Angle Adjustment


To open monitor, pull down on the release handle as shown. Adjust monitor screen vertically and position to user's optimum viewing angle.



Mute Function

Mute the audio sound.

 Press the MUTE button on the remote control or on the unit, displayed "MUTE" on the monitor and mute the audio sound.



 When mute is on, press the MUTE button again on the remote control or on the unit, displayed "MUTE OFF" on the monitor and play the audio sound.

Power And Mode Selection

Volume Control

Volume level is controlled by pressing the **VOL + / -** buttons.

W Volume Control consist of 20 steps.

Mode Setting


Select the desired mode by pressing the **MODE** button on the unit or on the remote control.

 $AV1 \rightarrow AV2$


For built in TV model, the mode will be changed as below;

AUX (AV1/AV2) Mode

1. Connect the external devices as shown below (refer Connection Diagram).



- 2. Turn the power on the unit and external devices.
- Select the AV1 or AV2 mode by pressing the MODE button on the unit or on the remote control.
- 4. Play the external device.

Picture Control

APC (Auto Picture Control)

Select the screen conditions.

Sound Control

BASS/TREBLE


 Bring up the on-screen FUNCTION menu by pressing the MENU button on the remote control or on the unit.

Connection Diagram




- 1. Connect the power cable and press the DOOR button on the unit.
- 2. Open the door and connect the +/- trigger wire with door trigger on the car, if lamp is on, please connect this wire with car door trigger.

Installation

1. Unpack the color box and check the contents.




2. Connect the external devices RCA cable or AV output. (refer the connection diagram)



3. Match the position of installation bracket and installation plate with 6 screws(screw A).

4. Tighten the unit with the supplied 4 screws(screw B).



Optional Specification

O FM TX

Listening to the audio portion of the disk through your automotive speakers.

 Bring up the on-screen FUNCTION menu by pressing the MENU button on the remote control or on the unit.

- Select the FM TX menu by pressing the
 CH ▲/▼ buttons on the remote control or
 the ▲/▼ buttons on the unit.
- 3. Select the Radio frequency from 88.3MHz~90.1MHz by pressing the ADJ ◀/▶ buttons on the remote control or the ADJ ⊕/⊙ buttons on the unit.




- 4. After setting the Radio frequency, control the radio volume.
- When FM TX is not installed or not working, you can hear the sound through IR headphone. (IR headphone is optional items)

Optional Specification

TV Mode

- Install the TV module on the product.
 Please check the Connection Diagram on the manual.
- Select the TV mode by pressing the MODE button on the remote control or on the unit.



How To Select Channels Automatically

- Press the A.MEMO button on the remote control to select all available channels automatically.
- * Channel may not be selected in a bad RF signal region.
- 2. After finishing the search channels, view channels and Add / Delete channel of your preference.

How To Add And Delete Channels Manually

Use to add or delete the channel as your taste.

- 1. Select the channels as you want by pressing the CH ▲/▼ buttons on the remote control or the ▲/▼ buttons on the unit.
- 2. Select add or delete the channels by pressing the **ADD/DEL** button on the remote control.

ADD: Add the channels those are not in the memorized channels. **DEL**: Delete the channels those are in the memorized channels.

Optional Specification

How To Select Channel

- Channels select on the SKIP mode.
 Display the TV channels only the memorized channels.
 After switching the SKIP MODE by pressing the SKIP/SEARCH button on the remote control, select the desired channel by pressing the ▲/▼ buttons on the unit or the CH ▲/▼ buttons on the remote control.
- 2. Channels select on the SEARCH mode. To view all channels. After switching the SEARCH MODE by pressing the SKIP/SEARCH button on the remote control, select the desired channel by pressing the ▲/▼ buttons on the unit or the CH ▲/▼ buttons on the remote control.

Channel Display

Press the **DISPLAY** button on the remote control, to displayed the channel on the right side of screen.
