

Watching the monitor for an extended period of time without the engine running may deplete the vehicle's battery charge.




Do not cover or stop up heater ducts or vents. It may be the origin of a fire or receives an electric shock.

Check Point


- 1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to 14°F~+131°F. Your vehicle can reach temperatures up to 212°F in the summertime.
- 2. From time to time when your vehicle extremely hot or cold you must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle to operating temperatures to return to normal operating rages. Your monitor will return to its normal functions when these operating ranges are achieved.
- 3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (+/-30 degrees).






1. Connect the external machinery and tools.



 Bring up the on-screen SETUP menu by pressing the PIC button on the remote control or on the unit.



 Select the Input mode by pressing the SEL ▲/▼ buttons on the remote control or the PIC button on the unit.



 Select the desired Input mode by pressing the ADJ ◄/▶ buttons on the remote control or on the unit.





5. Play the connected external devices(DVD, Game, Camcorder) with monitor.

Whenever press the PWR on the unit, you can select the desired Input mode. However, press the PWR on the unit during the 1 second. The unit will be POWER OFF.






