- ▲ Do not impact the monitor with a hard object. It may cause permanent damage.
- ▲ Do ground all equipments and works in order to avoid causing damage to the unit by electrostatic discharges.
- ▲ The user who handles this product takes all necessary precautions to avoid ESD (Electro-Static Discharge) failures.

UNIT INSTALLATION

Please read all of the instructions before beginning the installation. Recommend having your unit installed by a professional installation shop.

Tools and Supplies

You will need these tools and supplies to install your unit:

- . Torx type, flat-head and Philips screwdrivers
- . Wire cutters and strippers
- . Tools to remove existing radio (screwdriver, socket wrench set or other tools)
- . Electrical tape
- . Crimping tool
- . Volt meter/test light
- . Crimp connections
- . 18 gauge wire for power connections
- . 16~18 gauge speaker wire

Warnings:

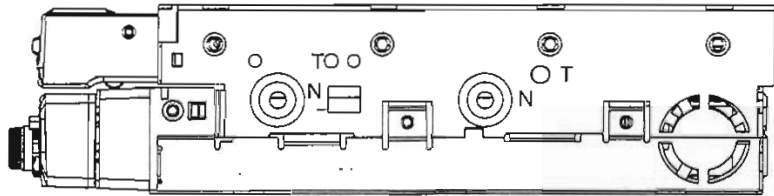
- ⚠ Choose the mounting location where the unit will not interfere with the safe driving conditions.
- ⚠ Install the unit where it does not get in the driver's way and can not injure the passenger if there is a sudden stop, like an emergency stop.
- ⚠ Avoid installing the unit where it would be subject to high temperature, such as from direct sunlight, or from hot air, from the heater, or where it would be subject to dust, dirt or excessive vibration.

Cautions:

- ⓘ Before finally installing the unit, connect the wiring temporarily and make sure it is all connected up properly, the unit and the system work properly.
- ⓘ Use only the parts included with the unit to ensure proper installation. The use of unauthorized parts can cause malfunctions.
- ⓘ Consult with your nearest dealer if installation requires the drilling of holes or other modifications of the vehicle.
- ⓘ If installation angle exceeds 30 degrees from horizontal, the unit might not give its optimum performance.

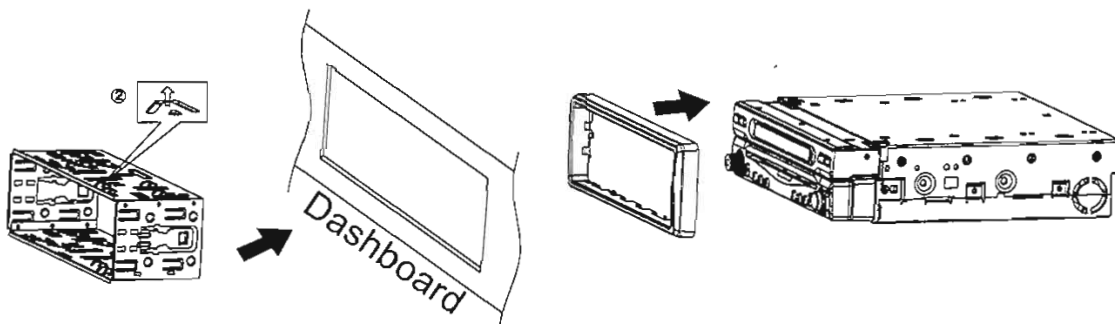

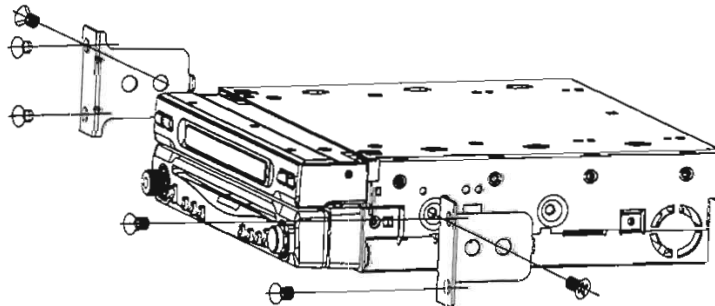
Installation Method 1

1. Bend the claws outward for tight fit, if necessary.
2. Install the Mounting Box into the dashboard, tighten the unit in place.
3. Install the Frame to the unit.



Installation Method 2

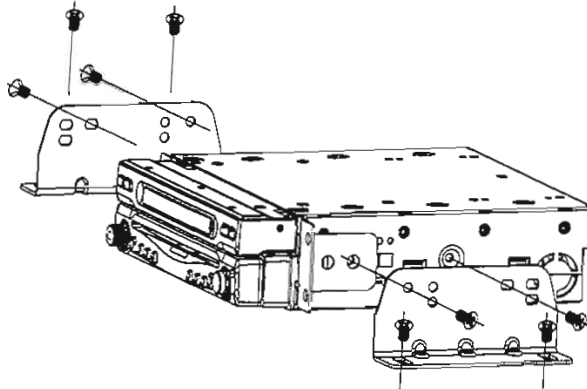
Select a position where the screw holes of the Mounting bracket supply with the car and the screw holes of the main unit become aligned, tighten the screws on each side then fasten them to car.

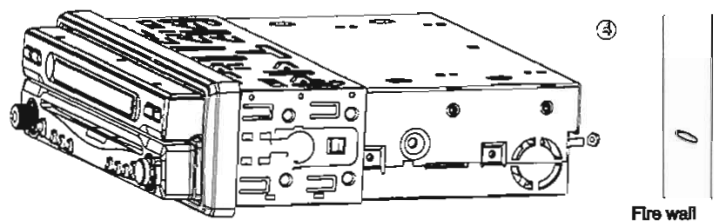

Select a position where the screw holes of the Mounting bracket supply with the car and the screw holes of the main unit become aligned, tighten the screws on each side then fasten them to car.



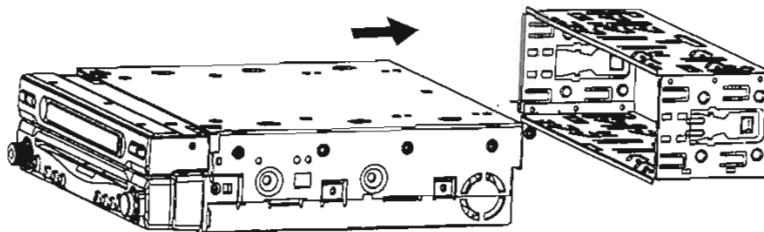
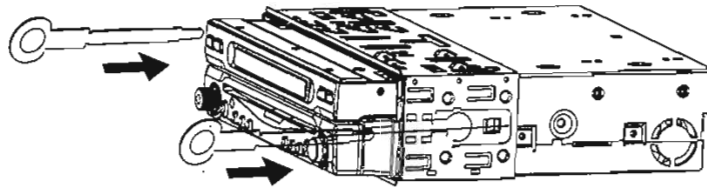
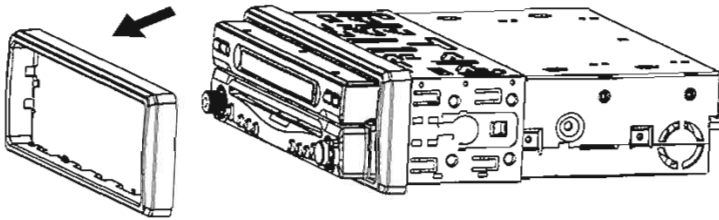
Installation Method 4

Use the Rear Mounting Bolt to support the unit.



UNIT REMOVAL

- Detach the front panel.
- Insert the keys that supply to the unit at both sides of the unit (shown as illustrated) until pull the keys to make it possible to remove the unit from the dashboard.



WIRING CONNECTION

Cautions:

- ① To prevent short circuits, remove the key from the ignition and disconnect the terminal of the battery.
- ① Make the proper input and output cable connections for each unit.
- ① Connect the wiring harness cables in the following order : ground wire, battery wire, ignition wire.
- ① Reconnect the terminal of the battery.
- ① Do not connect the yellow wire of this product directly to the battery terminal.
- ① Do remember to connect the red wire of this product to the ACC. of the ignition key switch. Failure to do may result in draining off the battery charge prematurely.
- ① If the fuse blows, first make sure that the cables have not caused a short circuit, then replace the old fuse with new one with the same rating.
- ① Do not let unconnected cables or terminals touch the metal on the car or Other conductor.
- ① To prevent short circuits, do not remove the caps form unused terminals or From the ends of the unconnected cables.
- ① After the monitor unit is installed, check whether the brake lamps, blinkers, wiper, etc. on the vehicle are working properly. If not, please make sure they are proper installed.
- ① Insulate unconnected wires with vinyl tape or other similar material.

Disconnecting the Battery

To prevent a short circuit, be sure to turn off the ignition and remove the negative(-) battery cable prior to installation.

Reconnecting the Battery

When wiring is complete, reconnect the battery negative terminal.

Warning:

Be sure to use the correct type and amperage Fuse to avoid damaging the unit.

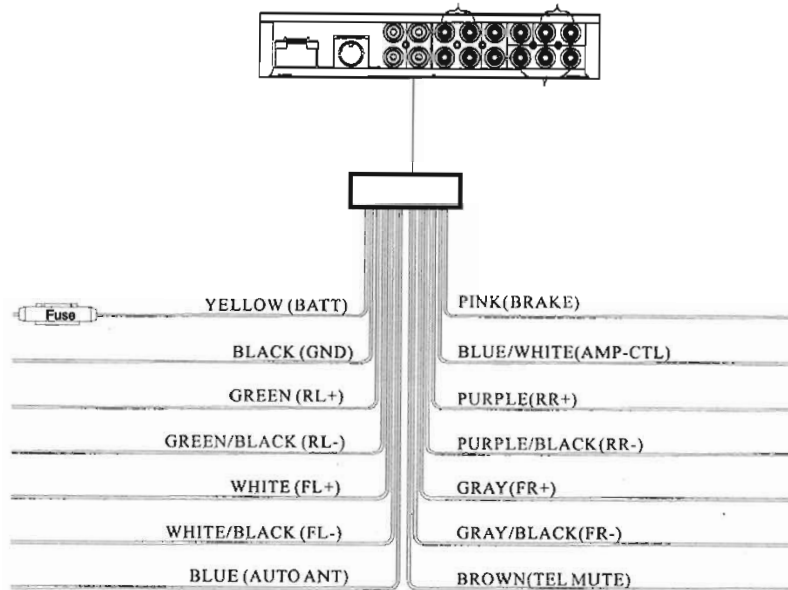

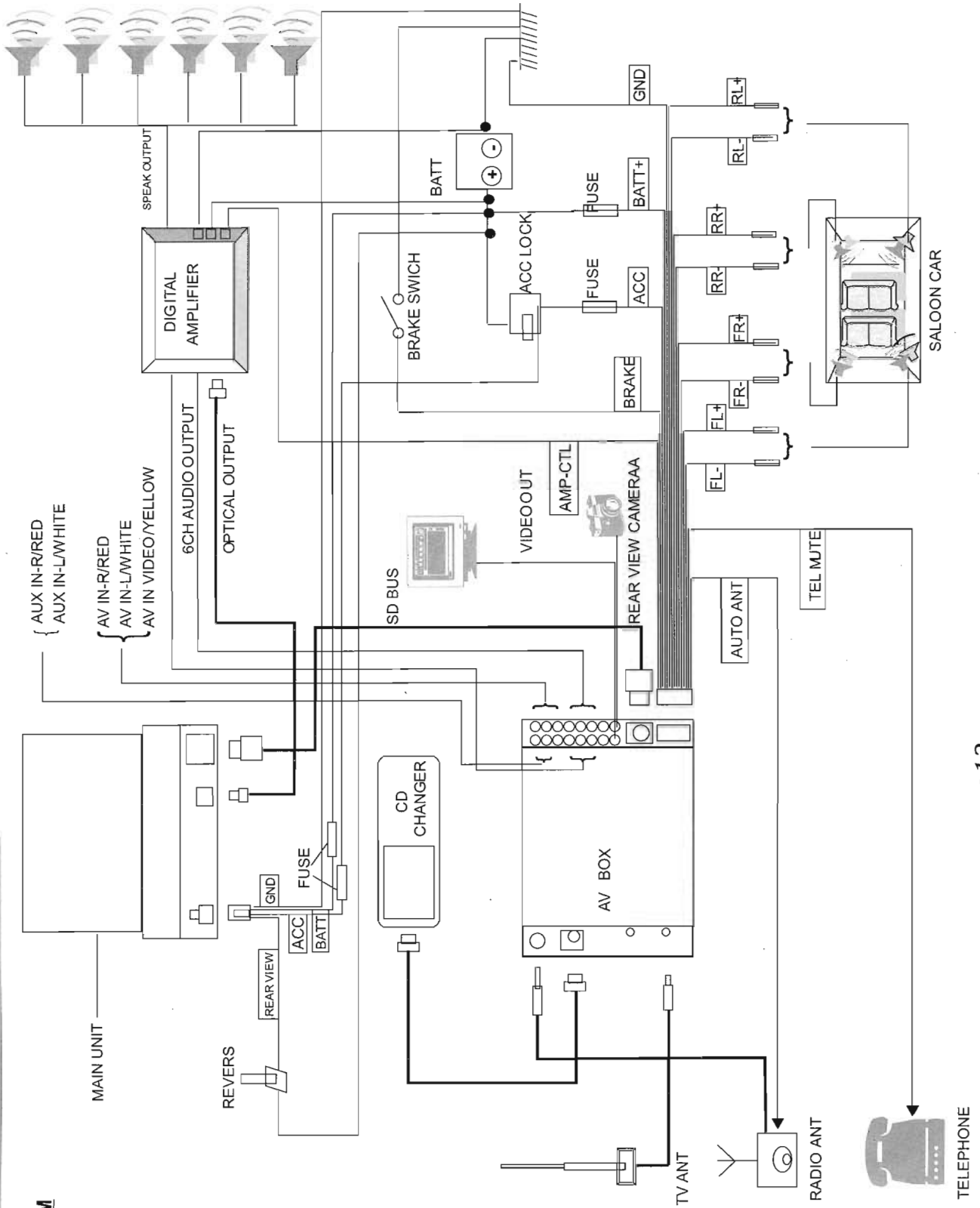

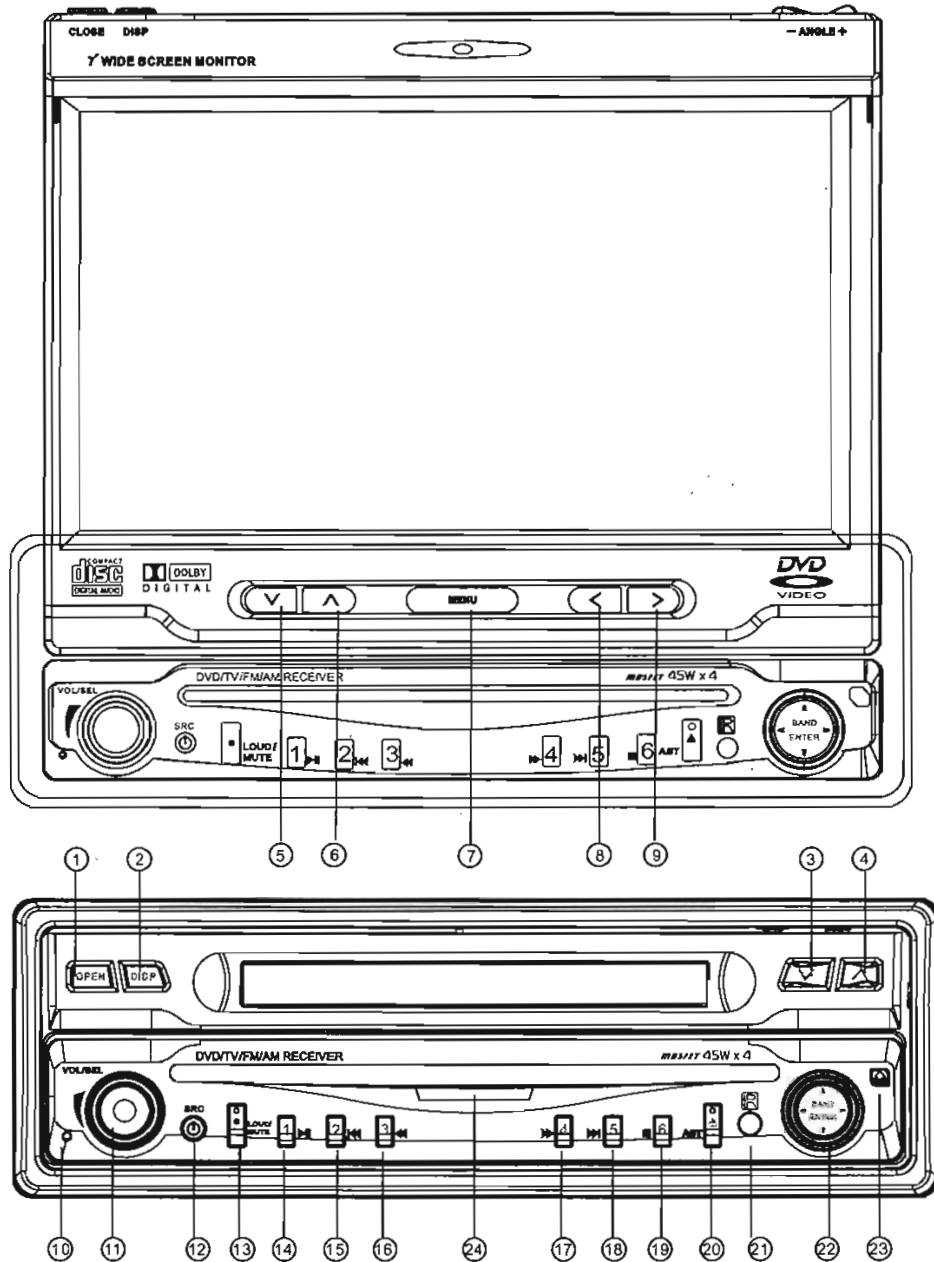
- ① If the TV antenna is mounted near a radio antenna, reception quality may be effected during simultaneous reception of TV and Radio broadcasts.
- ① If the hide-away unit is installed under a front seat, make sure it does not obstruct seat movement. Route all leads and cords carefully around the sliding mechanism so they do not get caught or pinched in the mechanism and cause a short circuit.
- ① If the hide-away unit is installed in the passenger compartment, anchor it securely so it does not break free while the car is moving, or cause injury or an accident.
- ① Please separate Battery Units before setting products to prevent from fire and electric shock. Mounting the antenna near to a radio antenna will result in noise. In this case, consult your dealer concerning mounting location.

1、 [OPEN]/ [CLOSE]

Press to open / close the Monitor.

2、 [DISP]

Press to switch the screen zoom mode between " FULL " and " NORMAL " .

3、 [ANGLE+]

Press to adjust the angle of TFT monitor upward by singly increasing.

Hold on pressing to adjust the angle of TFT monitor upward by continual increasing.

4、 [ANGLE -]

Press to adjust the angle of TFT monitor downward by singly decreasing.

Hold on pressing to adjust the angle of TFT monitor downward by continual decreasing.

5、 [V]

Press to move the cursor downward to select item.

6、 [^]

Press to move the cursor upward to select item.

7、 [MENU]

Press to enter / exit the Picture Parameter Setup of the TFT monitor.

Press to decrease the parameter value of item.

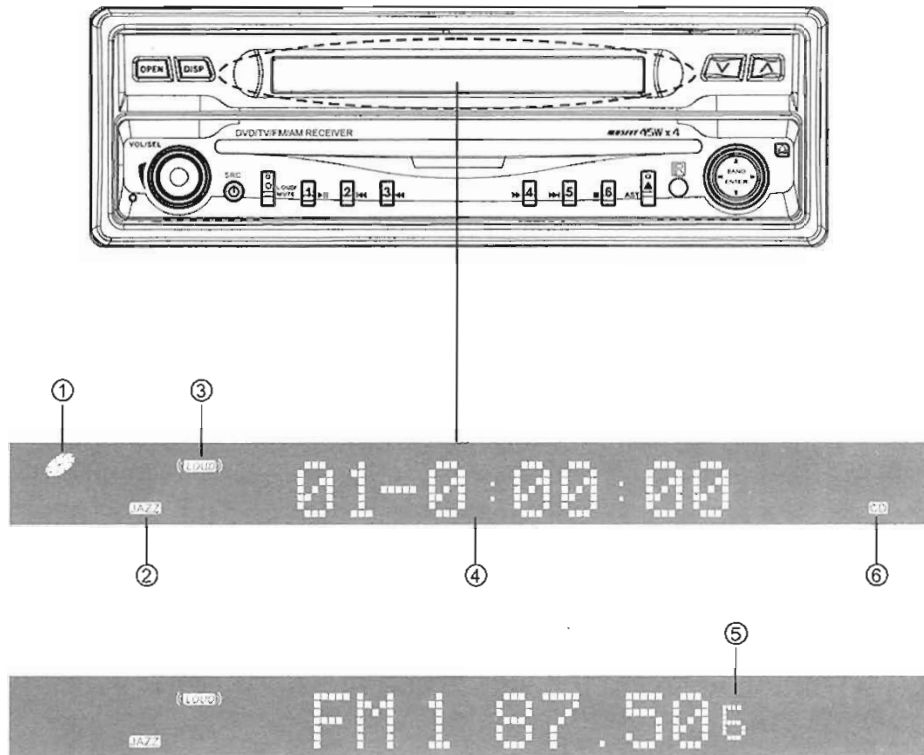



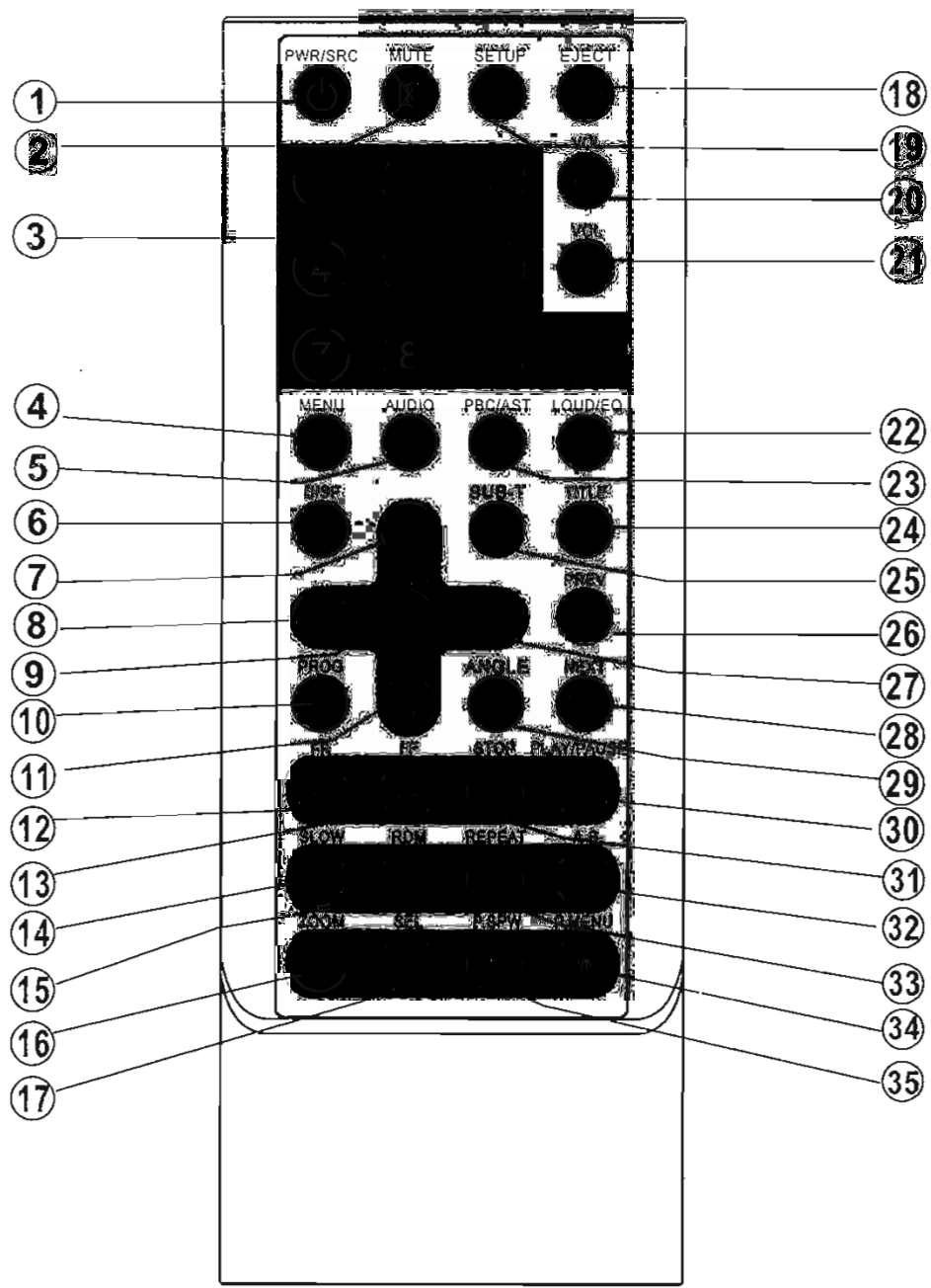

- ❶ () Disc Icon:
It rotates when playing disc under the DVD Mode.
- ❷ The EQ Indicator:
It turns on to indicate the POP、CLASS、JAZZ、ROCK when corresponding setup.
It turns off when custom setup.
- ❸ () LOUD Icon:
It displays when the LOUD function on.
It disappears when the LOUD function off.
- ❹ Main Display Area:
Display the information such as characters, playback time of disc, radio frequency etc.
- ❺ Auxiliary Display Area:
Radio Mode: display the preset station number.
DVD Mode: display the DVD chapters.
- ❻ Disc Type Indicator:
It turns on to indicate DVD, CD, VCD, and MP3 when playing corresponding discs.

1. [PWR/SRC]

Press to turn the unit on when power off.
Press to switch the modes when power on.
Hold on pressing to turn the unit off.

2. [MUTE]

Press to enter / exit the Picture-Parameter Setup of the TFT monitor.

3. [0~9]

1~6, press these buttons to store the current radio station or recall the stored station under the Radio Mode.
0~9, press these buttons to select the tracks, and input the code.

4. [MENU]

Press to return to the boot menu when playing DVD disc.
Press to select PBC on / off when playing VCD disc.

5. [AUDIO]

Press to select dialogue language when playing DVD disc.
Press to select left audio channel, right audio channel or stereo when playing VCD disc.

6. [DISP]

Press to display current playback information when playing DVD disc.

7. [▲], 8. [◀], 11. [▼], 27. [▶] Direction Key

Under the Setup menu:

Hold on pressing to turn the LOUD function on / off.
23. **[PBC/AST]**
Press to turn the PBC function on / off when playing VCD disc.
Hold on pressing to seek radio station / TV channel automatically under RADIO / TV Modes.
24. **[TITLE]**
Press to enter the title menu when playing DVD disc.
25. **[SUB-T]**
Press to select the subtitle language when playing DVD disc.
26. **[PREV]**
Press to skip to play the pervious track.
28. **[NEXT]**
Press to skip to play the next track.

29. [PLAY/PAUSE]

Press to pause playback when playing; press again to continue playing.

30. [STOP]

Press to stop playback.

31. [A-B]

Press to setup A-B repeat playing.

32. [REPEAT]

Press to select the chapter / title / disc to repeat playing.

33. [P.MENU/P/N]

Press the button to switch the video output (PAL/NTSC) when playing DVD disc.
Hold on pressing to enter / exit the Picture Parameter Setup of the TFT Monitor.

34. [P.SPW/ST]

Press to turn the stereo on / off under Radio Mode.
Hold on pressing to open / close the TFT Monitor.

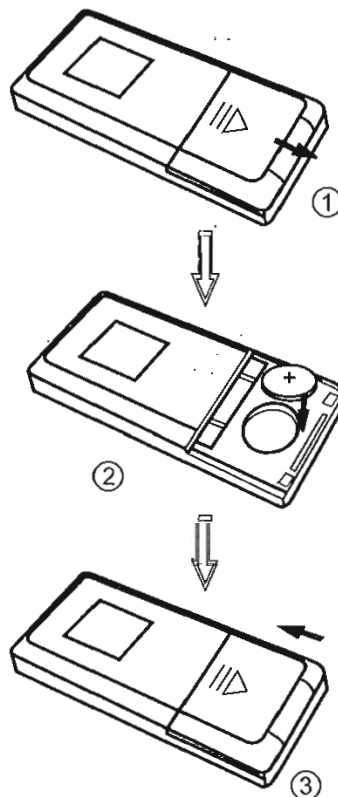
REPLACING THE BATTERIES

If the remote control has no function or if the operating range reduced, replace the old battery with new one.

❶ Pull out the battery holder. Follow the arrow 1 slide it to the right toward the battery while at the same time pull the battery holder away from the remote control.

❷ Place the new battery. Place the new lithium battery with the (+) side up.

❸ Push the holder back. Using the finger to push in the holder back until the locking sound is heard.



OPERATION

TFT MONITOR OPERATION

❶ Open the TFT Monitor

Press the [OPEN] button or hold on pressing the [P.SPW] button, the monitor will spread out, and turn around to the last angle position.

❷ Close the TFT Monitor

Press the [CLOSE] button or hold on pressing the [P.SPW] button, the monitor will turn downward and completely retract in.

Notes:

- ❶ When car back up, the monitor will extend automatically to display the picture taken by the backup camera if monitor closed.

View Angle Adjustments

Adjust the angle of the monitor to choose the best displaying effect.

❶ Continual angle adjustment

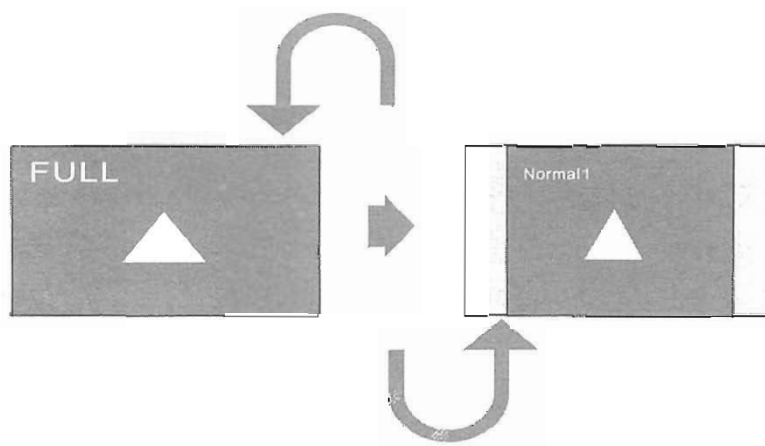
Hold on pressing the [ANGLE+/-] button to adjust the angle upward/downward by continual increasing/decreasing.

❷ Single step angle adjustment

Press the [ANGLE+/-] button to adjust the angle upward/downward by singly increasing/decreasing.

Display Mode

Press the [DISP] button of the monitor, the display proportion will switch between " FULL " and " NORMAL " .



OPERATION

Picture Parameter Setup

The video output of the five playing source as follows:

❶ Press the [MENU] button on the TFT monitor or hold on pressing the [P.MENU] button to enter the Picture Parameter Setup menu. Press the button again to exit.

❷ Press the [▲] / [▼] buttons on the TFT monitor, the controller or the remote control to choose the adjust items.

❸ Press the [<] / [>] buttons on the TFT monitor, controller or the remote control to adjust the parameter value.



Notes:

- ❶ The default value is 15.
The TINT can not be adjusted under the PAL system.

OPERATION

Brake Control

It is necessary to connect the Brake Control wire to the Hand-brake switch of the car. While driving, the TFT monitor will display the alarm picture (see as follows) in order to ensure the safety.

Under the Rear View Mode, the Brake Control function is no effective.



Protection of the TFT Monitor

During the movement of the TFT monitor, if it is halted by force, then the unit will begin self-protection to prevent from any damage on the motorized mechanical structure. Press the [OPEN] button or shut down the ACC and then restart, the TFT monitor will act as the follow list to recover; if not, then please consult with an authorized service center.

OPERATION

BASIC FUNCTIONS OPERATION

Startup

Press the [PWR/SRC] button on the panel or remote control to startup the power, the TFT monitor will spread out automatically and the system return to the working Mode when last turnoff.

Turnoff

Hold on pressing the [PWR/SRC] button on the panel or remote control to turnoff the power, the TFT monitor will retract automatically.

Notes:

- ① Close the ACC without turnoff, the unit will turnoff automatically; and the TFT monitor will retract within 10 seconds automatically to protect the TFT monitor. Start the ACC again, the unit will startup and return to the last working Mode automatically, but the monitor does not spread out.

Detachable Front Panel

The front panel is detachable.

Taking out the front panel and the unit will turnoff automatically; and the TFT monitor will retract automatically.

Notes:

- ① This function is burglarproof for unit security.

Mute Control

① Press the [LOUD/MUTE] button on the panel or the [MUTE] button on the remote control to mute the sound; press it again to mute off.

② When mute the sound, adjust the sound volume to mute off.

③ When mute the sound, there is a red MUTE icon on TFT monitor under the RADIO Mode; and there are red Volume icon and MUTE icon under other Modes.

Working Mode

Press the [PWR/SRC] button to switch the working Mode as following:

DVD→TUNER→TV→AUX→AV IN→CDC→DVD

Notes:

- ① It can not switch to CDC Mode if unit no connection with a CD Changer.
- ② Under AUX Mode, there are Audio Input but no Video Input.

Volume Control

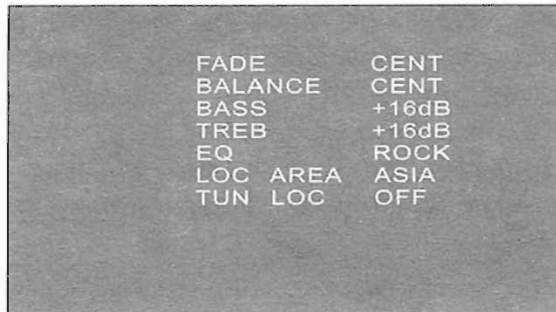
① Rotate the [VOL] button clockwise / anticlockwise to increase / decrease the volume. Press the [VOL+] / [VOL-] buttons on the remote control to increase / decrease the volume.

② The adjustable range of the volume is 0~40.

OPERATION

Sound Parameter Setup

1. Press the [VOL] button vertically on the panel or the [SEL] button on the remote control to enter the Sound Parameter Setup menu. Press the button again to exit.



2. Press the [▲] / [▼] buttons on the TFT monitor, or the controller or the remote control to move the cursor on the adjustable items.
3. Press the [<] / [>] buttons on the TFT monitor, or the controller or the remote control to adjust the parameter value.

Notes:

- ① F14 represents the loudest sound volume from Front Audio Output, while no sound from the Roud Audio Output.
- ① L14 represents the loudest sound volume from Left Audio Output, while no sound from the Right Audio Output.

OPERATION

Loud Control

Hold on pressing the [EQ/LOUD] button to turn the LOUD function on / off.
There is a " LOUD " icon on the TFT monitor display when LOUD function on.

Telephone Mute Control

Connect the telephone mute control wire " TEL_MUTE " (see Wiring Diagram).
If there is a vehicle call comes in, the sound volume will be automatically reduced to a very small value, and TFT monitor shows: " YOU GET A PHONE " ;
when call finished, the sound volume will recover to former volume, and the words " YOU GET A PHONE " disappear.

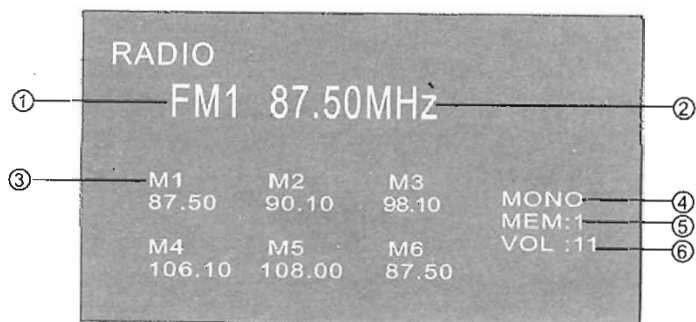
Auto Antenna Control

Connect the auto antenna control wire " AUTO_ANT " (see Wiring Diagram);
the antenna will lift when the unit startup; it will descend when the unit turnoff.

RADIO TUNER (FM/AM) OPERATION

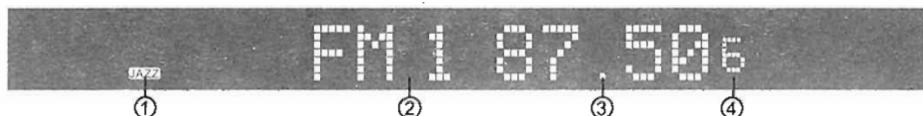

Handling and Cleaning >>

- Dirty, dusty, scratched or warped discs will cause misoperation.
- Do not place stickers or make scratches on discs.
- Do not warp discs.
- A disc should always be kept in its case when not in use to prevent from damage.
- Do not place discs in the following places:
 1. Direct sunlight.
 2. Dirty, dusty and damp areas.
 3. High temperature places.
 4. On the seats or dashboard.

Disc Cleaning >>

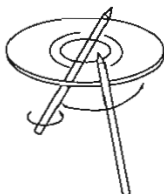
Use a dry soft cloth to wipe the surface. If the disc is quite dirty, use a soft cloth slightly moist with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol. Never use solvent such as benzene, thinner or conventional record cleaners which may mar the surface of the disc.

Notes:

- ① A disc may become somewhat scratched (although not enough to make it unusable) depending on your handling it in the condition of the usage environment. These scratches are not an indication of any problem with the player.

Repairing New Discs with Rough Spots

A new disc may have rough edges on its inside and outside edges. If a disc with rough edges is used, the proper setting will not be performed and the player will not play the disc. Therefore, remove the rough edges in advance by using a ballpoint pen or pencil. To remove the rough edges, press the side of the pen or pencil against the inside and outside edges of the disc.



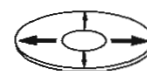
Label side up
